KEY TERMS:

Ecclesiology: the branch of theology that is concerned with the nature, constitution, and functions of a church.

<u>Protestant</u>: a member of any of several church denominations denying the universal authority of the Pope and affirming Reformation principles; *broadly*, **it pertains to** a Christian not of the Roman Catholic or Eastern Church.

<u>Orthodoxy</u>: conforming to the Christian faith as represented in the creeds of the early church. It generally pertains to the beliefs and practices of the Eastern Orthodox Church.
