Today, we will learn more about the sacraments of Holy Orders and Anointing of the Sick.

Ordination: the process by which individuals are consecrated, that is, set apart as clergy to perform various religious rites and ceremonies.

Extreme Unction: the name given to the sacrament of Anointing of Sick as it became more and more a sacrament exclusively given to those at the point of death.

Viaticum: the name given to the sacraments of Anointing of the Sick and the Eucharist as they are administered to someone at the point of death.
